## REPAIR & REPLACEMENT OF 0-6 MONTHS OF AGE CALF HOUSING

The purpose of this guideline is to determine the level of repair and replacement for calf housing structures that were originally planned and constructed for 0-6 months of age dairy calves. The current planning guideline for dairy calf housing structures accommodates 0-3 months only.

Participants that have existing calf housing structures that accommodate 0-6 months of age dairy calves.

- 1. If there is adequate room for all age groups in the current structure, then WAP will repair or replace following the prioritization methodology.
- 2. If there is **Not** adequate room for all age groups in the current structure;
  - 1. Landowner available housing for the 3-6 months of age calves will be the first option.
  - 2. If there is no alternate housing available for the 3-6 months of age;
    - a. A new 0-3 months of age calf housing structure will be considered.
    - b. The original 0-6 month structure will be relinquished to the landowner to use for the older aged animals, if the life-span for that BMP has expired. The landowner would sign a hold harmless agreement and the WAP would no longer be responsible for repair or replacement of this structure.
- 3. Non-Engineered (No Engineer structural approval) calf housing structures would be replaced and not repaired due to the types and quality of materials, in accordance with 1 & 2 above.
- 4. Calf Housing structures that were constructed and the landowner paid for the 3-6 months of age portion of the structure will be repaired as follows;

  The landowner will be responsible for the costs of any repair or replacement to the 3-6 months portion of the structure. The landowner must comply with all BMP Procurement Procedures to satisfy their costs.
- 5. If the existing 0-6 months of age calf structures have reached their lifespan and are converted to another use they will no longer be considered for 3-6 months of age calf housing repair or replacement. These structures would only be considered for BMP repair or replacement of 0-3 months of age calf housing, if they convert back to a dairy operation.
