Option 1: Environmental Center & Reservoir Trip

Taconic Outdoor Education Center (day & overning) overnight trips)

Programming:

Day rates for students include a selection of classes and depend on who is providing lunch. Adults are charged only for meals:

- Bring your own lunch: \$15/student; no charge for adults •
- TOEC provides lunch: \$25/student; \$15 per adult

Overnight trip rates for students include programming, lodging, and meals. Adult rates cover lodging and meals.

- Overnight (1 night, 4 meals, programming) \$105 per student; \$75 per adult.
- Two nights (2 nights, 6 meals, programming) \$170 per student; \$125 per adult.

OPEX (Operation Explore):

Special field trip option for NYC schools includes 2 nights at TOEC, visit to Stony Kill Farm and a NYC Watershed reservoir tour with WAC. Teachers must attend fall training to participate. \$3,000.00 per class of 32 students plus 4 adults, up to 3 students can be added per class. \$95.00 for each extra student or adult. Maximum 2 classes per trip.

Bus Rates:

Bus costs will vary depending on the type of bus (yellow school bus or coach), distance traveled and time of year.*

- For high school groups traveling less than 2 hours, consider hiring a yellow school bus: \$500-1,000/bus.
- For elementary & middle school groups traveling 1.5 hours or more, consider hiring a coach bus: \$1,100-1,600/bus.

- Aquatic Ecology & Watersheds (Sept-Oct & May-June) •
- Soil Ecology (Apr-Dec)
- Environmental Issues, e.g. Water Use •
